White-crowned Sparrows are very common birds that can be spotted in the Sonoran Desert during the winter months - usually October through March.

They can easily be identified by their distinctive black and white striped head, gray face and underparts, tan back, and pink bill. You may find them fluttering about the parks feeding on seeds from grasses, forbs, hackberries, and wolfberries.
