

WESTERN BANDED GECKO



Western Banded Gecko (Colenyx variegatus)

- Delicate and surprisingly small, rarely exceed a total length of 4-6 inches.
- Movable eyelids and larger vertical pupils.
- Small body scales and slender toes with round pads.
- The body is sandy-colored and has dark crossbands broken into patches, and they have a translucent appearance.
- They are nocturnal and their diet consists mostly of insects, and they are known to feed on baby scorpions, helping control their populations. So great to have in your yard (nature's very own pest control).
