PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING

ITEM #1 - CALL TO ORDER - Anne Lynch, Chair, Maricopa County Parks and Recreation Commission

The regular meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m.

ITEM #2 - ROLL CALL - Roll Call taken - a quorum was present.

ITEM #3 - RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PLAN GUIDELINE MANUAL COMMENTS - R.J. Cardin, Director, Maricopa County Parks and Recreation Department - INFORMATION ITEM

Director Cardin reminded the commissioners that the Resource Management Plan Guideline Manual link had been sent to each member for review and comments. Comments are due by November 1, 2017.

ITEM #4 – PROPOSED PARKS FEE SCHEDULE REVISIONS – SET PUBLIC HEARING FOR NOVEMBER 14, 2017 – R.J. Cardin, Director, Maricopa County Parks and Recreation Department – INFORMATION/DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEM

Director Cardin presented the 2017 Fee Study Survey results. The Commission's discussion included: Entry Fees: the proposed fees were discussed. After review and impact discussions, the Commission requested the \$8 day-use entry fee for Lake Pleasant be adjusted to stay the same as the mountain parks at \$7. The increase to the Hike/Bike/Equestrian, commercial bus, and commercial van should be removed.

Camping Fees: the proposed fees were discussed. The Commission agreed the fee increase was acceptable. Higher camping fees for out-of-state/non-residents were discussed but not recommended due to the increased enforcement burden.

Annual Passes: Commissioner Merdon asked if the revenue impact for a 6-month seasonal pass had been considered; staff is proposing a one year trial period to analyze the data. The 6-month seasonal passes were removed pending further information from the future visitor survey. It was agreed the proposed fees for Additional cards, replacement cards, and a new Hike/Bike/Equestrian annual pass should move forward.

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- Other Fees: discussion on Special Use Permit Application fee was held. The increase fee is an administrative fee to cover the cost of setting up the special use permits. The increased fee was recommended.
- ➤ Commissioner Budruk motioned to set a hearing for November 14, 2017, to receive public input regarding the proposed fee revisions. Seconded by Commissioner Merdon. Ayes: Budruk, Merdon, Lynch. Nays: Branch.
