

HOW TO PURCHASE AN ANNUAL PASS

Most Maricopa County Park locations (excluding Adobe Dam, Buckeye Hills, and Spur Cross) sell annual passes. The pass may be used on your first visit and is valid at the following locations:

- Buckeye Hills Regional Park
- Cave Creek Regional Park
- Estrella Mountain Regional Park
- Hassayampa River Preserve
- Lake Pleasant Regional Park
- McDowell Mountain Regional Park
- San Tan Mountain Regional Park
- Spur Cross Ranch Conservation Area
- Utery Mountain Regional Park
- White Tank Mountain Regional Park

ITEMS NOT COVERED BY THE ANNUAL PASS

- Special use permits (SUP)
- Fee based programs
- Concessionaire services
- Camping - additional vehicles and watercraft are also not covered
- Ramada rentals

Additional exclusions may apply. Contact the park for more details.

HOW TO USE THE SELF-PAY STATION (IRON RANGER)

If there is not a staff member present when you enter (either at the entry station or from a park trailhead), please do the following:

- Stop at the entrance.
- Use a self-pay envelope to write your annual pass number and the number of people in your vehicle (this helps our team understand park usage, and is used to assist with programming efforts)
- If entering via a vehicle, ensure your hangtag is easily visible from your dashboard or rearview mirror.

MARICOPA COUNTY PARKS ANNUAL PASS

Annual passes provide a convenient and affordable way to visit Maricopa County's regional parks. The passes offer day-use access to more than 120,000 acres of pristine Sonoran Desert parkland.

Annual passes are:

- Valid for one year from the date of purchase for day-use access only.
- Not transferable from person to person. The passholder must be present or in the vehicle. If a person other than the pass owner requests entry, Park staff will place the pass on "hold" until the pass owner arrives. Photo identification may be required to verify ownership.
- Not a priority pass and does not guarantee entry to the parks when capacity limits have been reached, or temporary closures are enacted.
- Valid at any Maricopa County Regional Park.
- Able to be downloaded electronically to your phone (e.g. Apple/Google wallet, etc.).

BENEFITS OF BEING AN ANNUAL PASSHOLDER

1. Support the Parks: 100 percent of the proceeds from the pass sales are used to improve and enhance visitor recreation services. Maricopa County Parks are primarily funded by revenues generated from park visitor entry fees and visitor support – not taxpayer dollars.
2. Discounts on Souvenir/Fee-Based Programming: Annual Pass holders receive 10 percent off on souvenir items in the nature centers and Fee-Based programming. Exclusions may apply.
3. Promotes a Healthy Lifestyle: Being actively involved in nature regularly helps to reduce anxiety/stress, improve mood, enhance cognition, strengthen immunity, boost self-esteem, improve sleep, lower disease risk, provide opportunities for social engagement, and so much more.

ANNUAL PASS OPTIONS

There are two types of annual pass options:

- Day-Use Annual Pass
- Hike/Bike/Horseback Annual Pass

DAY-USE ANNUAL PASS

Includes entry for a single, private, non-commercial vehicle entry with passengers or up to four park visitors (including the passholder) entering via hiking, biking, or horseback.

Pass Level	# of Passes	Passholders Included	Rate

Tier 2	2 Annual Passes	Plus an Additional Household Member	\$150
Tier 3	3 Annual Passes	Plus Two Additional Household Members	\$170
Tier 4	4 Annual Passes	Plus Three Additional Household Members	\$185

HIKE/BIKE/HORSEBACK ANNUAL PASS FOR \$40

Includes non-motorized entry for an individual passholder entering via hiking (walking), biking (cyclists) or horseback (equestrians). Additional passholders and vehicle entries are not eligible with this pass.

DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE

The following discounts are available for eligible annual passholders and cannot be combined:

- Senior Discount
- Disabled Veteran

Discounts may only be applied to the following:

- Primary passholder in a tiered package
- Purchase price for a Day-Use Annual Pass (Hike/Bike/Horseback Annual Pass is not eligible)

The discount rate shall be applied to the year in which the pass is purchased. **Only one discount can be applied per annual pass package.**

Senior Discount (For Customers 65 Years of Age and Older)

The senior discount will be applied and adjusted annually. The discounts are as follows:

Disabled Veteran - \$60.00

Disability status verification will be required at the time of pick-up using one of the following:

- A valid government-issued ID that clearly states "Service Connected Disability".
- Letter from the Department of Veterans' Affairs stating the Veteran has a service-connected disability. The letter must be dated within the last ten (10) years.
 - A U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Identification Card may also be provided in place of the letter.
 - The card needs to state "Service Connected" under the veteran's picture.

ADD-ON ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Add-on services must be purchased at the same time as the annual pass purchase. If add-on items are not added to the pass, you will be required to pay the standard park entry fee each visit to the park for such items. The following items are eligible to be added to the Day-Use Annual Pass (add-ons not eligible for Hike/Bike/Horseback Annual Pass):

- Archery (16 years and older):
 - \$48 per archer per year
- Boating:
 - \$65 per motorized watercraft per year
 - \$30 per non-motorized watercraft per year

HANG TAGS

- Hang tag(s) are issued at the time of purchase with each Annual Pass.
- Must always be displayed and easily visible in vehicles while in the park.
- Lost or stolen hang tags may be replaced at no additional cost.
