

CAMPFIRE SAFETY TIPS



BUILD FIRES IN DESIGNATED PLACES.

FIND OUT IF THE AREA HAS AN EXISTING FIRE RING

OR FIRE PIT.



IF NOT, BUILD ONE FROM SCRATCH BY SELECTING A LEVEL, OPEN LOCATION AWAY FROM HEAVY FUELS SUCH AS BRUSH AND GROUND COVERAGE.



BUILDING AN OPEN CAMPFIRE



SCOOP A DEPRESSION IN THE CENTER OF THE CLEARED AREA TO BUILD THE FIRE AND PUT A RING OF ROCKS AROUND IT.



KEEP A BUCKET OF WATER AND A SHOVEL NEARBY.



KEEP YOUR FIRE A MANAGEABLE SIZE.



THE FIRE SHOULD BE
BUILT NO LARGER THAN
NECESSARY FOR COOKING
OR PERSONAL WARMTH.



YOUR FIRE MUST NEVER BE LEFT UNATTENDED AND THE FIRE MUST BE EXTINGUISHED COMPLETELY BEFORE LEAVING.



THE FIRE IS BURNING



KEEP A SHOVEL AND BUCKET OF WATER NEARBY AT ALL TIMES.



WHILE FIRE IS BURNING, BE SURE THERE IS AN ADULT IN ATTENDANCE AND OVERSEEING THE FIRE AT ALL TIMES.



NEVER LEAVE
CHILDREN AROUND AN
UNATTENDED FIRE.



COMPLETELY EXTINGUISH AN OPEN CAMPFIRE



USE THE "DROWN, STIR AND FEEL" METHOD. DROWN THE FIRE WITH WATER, THEN STIR AROUND THE FIRE AREA WITH YOUR SHOVEL TO WET ANY REMAINING EMBERS AND ASH.



FEEL AREA WITH THE BACK OF YOUR HAND TO ENSURE NOTHING IS STILL SMOLDERING.



TURN WOOD AND COALS OVER AND WET ALL SIDES.



MOVE SOME DIRT ONTO THE FIRE SITE AND MIX THOROUGHLY TO FULLY SMOTHER IT.



ALLOWED:
SMOKING, GAS/PROPANE GRILLS IN
DESIGNATED AREAS SUCH AS RAMADA AREAS,
SEMI-DEVELOPED AND DEVELOPED CAMP SITES.

NOT ALLOWED: CAMPFIRES, FIRE PITS AND CHARCOAL GRILLS.
