Meeting Notes

Feedback from stakeholders:

ALTERNATIVE B -

- Include map(s) for each alternative
- What are costs?
 - The implementation plan will look into costs once a final alternative is chosen.
- Clarify the status of turf between/near ramadas
- Desire for large family groups to play at ramadas on turf
- White clover (environmental grass) grass, deep roots, draught tolerant, supports bees/pollinators, no burs
- Tree replacement program (to include/consider food bearing trees)

ALTERNATIVE C –

- Highlight new opportunities from previous opportunities
- What is purpose of land acquisition (C18)
- Events area for events and races

General comments -

- List potential partners on each alternative
- Maps to show areas, especially camping areas and sizes
- List group of stakeholders and youth groups to show public participation up front
- Simplify alternatives to bullet points and maps
- Maintain family friendly message of the park
- Provide maps to stakeholders after meeting (completed)
- Keep an eye to the future, green technologies, solar on ramadas, gray water, rainwater harvest
- Issues that effect change? Noise, light, etc.
- Impacts from improvements? Good or bad? Noise, light
 - Ex: lighting impacts with new technologies and examples
 - Ex: noise – max. load of vehicles/turnover of games, vehicle counts, provide to public, outline mitigation measures to public
- Show a “no action” alternative. Show the results of no action: further degradation of turf or other resources, etc. from lack of funding etc.
- Simplify
- Present one long list of High/Medium/Low priority rather than by alternative
- Show what we are doing and why
