## **GREAT HORNED OWL**

This month, we are learning all about the Great Horned Owl (*Bubo virginianus*). Here are some fun and key facts:

- Great Horned owls are adapted to extreme temperatures and can thrive in a variety of ecosystems.
- Owls have extra vertebrae in their neck, allowing them to turn 270 degrees and at speed.
- Owls are stealthy nocturnal hunters due to their fringed feathers with serrated edges on their wings, allowing them to fly silently, sneaking up on their prey.
