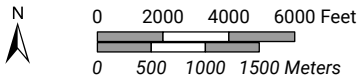
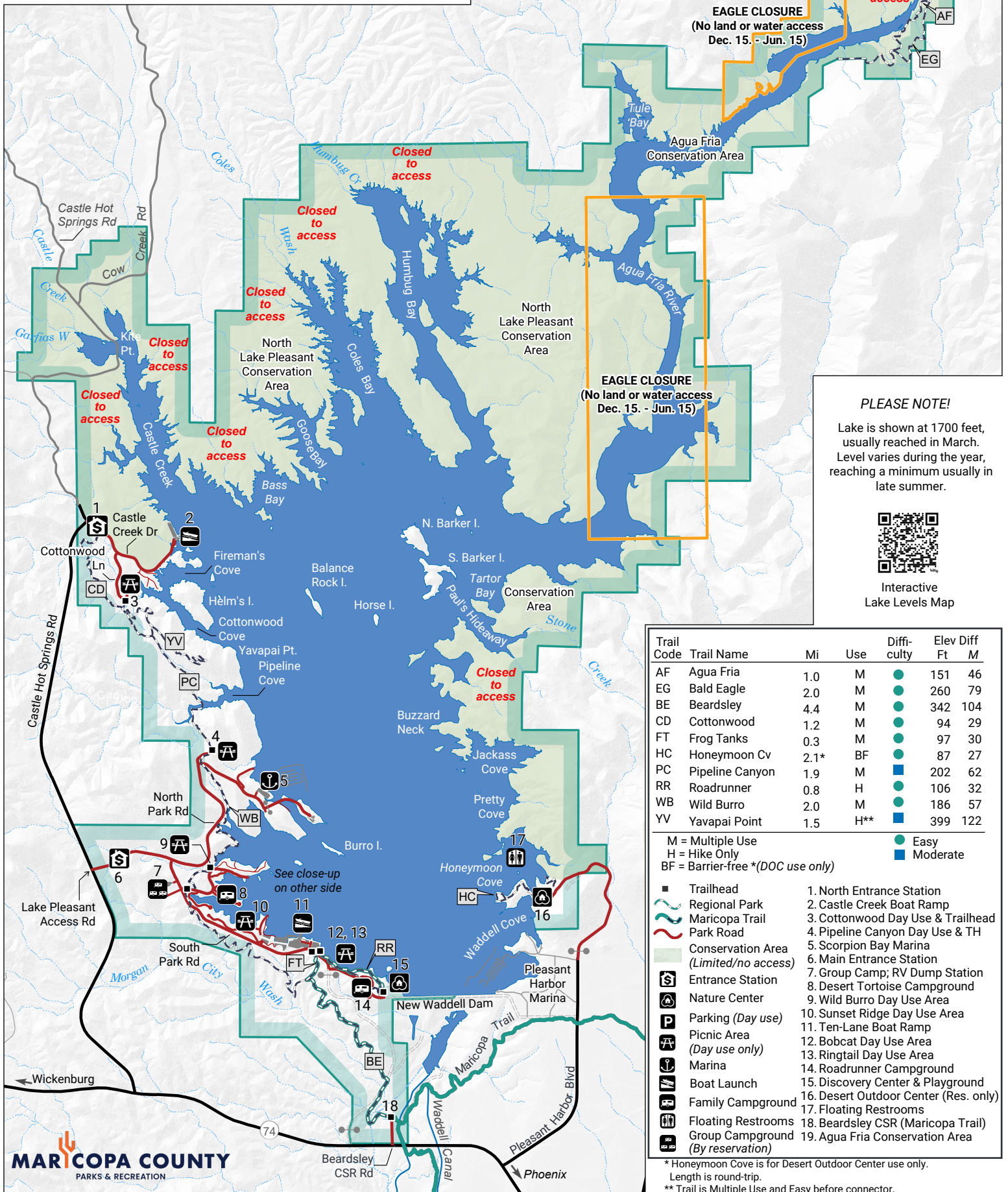

Prohibited Actions/Items:

- Touching, harassing or feeding burros/wildlife
- Removal/damage to resources (e.g. vegetation, collecting firewood and wildflowers)
- Wood or charcoal fires during a fire ban or no burn day (propane use is permitted)
- Amplified music and/or commercial activities/events without a permit
- Off-road/off-trail travel
- Glass bottles/containers
- Pets not on a leash
- Target shooting
- Cliff jumping
- Littering
- Drones

Camping:

- Observe quiet time hours from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Check-in no earlier than 1 p.m. (day of arrival)
- Check-out no later than 12 p.m. (day of departure)
- Park on designated driveways or within designated overflow parking areas
- Campsite limits:
 - Maximum of eight (8) people
 - Two (2) vehicles, and
 - No more than two (2) tents; or one (1) RV and one (1) tent

Restrooms:

Restroom facilities are available at all developed areas. Portable restroom facilities are located at various areas around the park.
